Barbara M. Wirostko, MD, FARVO
Dr. Wirostko is a chief medical officer (CMO) and adjunct professor of ophthalmology, with specialized fellowship training in glaucoma. She treats glaucoma and comprehensive ophthalmology patients and specializes in clinical research. Dr. Wirostko is also a serial entrepreneur, experienced board member, and industry leader with a track record of global pharmaceutical drug and device development. She has started, developed, managed, and raised funds for for-profit startups and not-for-profit organizations.



Marissa Larochelle, MD
Dr. Larochelle is an assistant professor of ophthalmology specializing in cataract surgery and ocular inflammatory disease. She is one of just three fellowship-trained Uveitis specialists in the Mountain West. Dr. Larochelle has studied and published on ways to improve management and diagnosis of debilitating inflammatory eye diseases. She has done ophthalmology outreach in the Dominican Republic, Myanmar, and the Navajo Nation.



Eileen Hwang, MD, PhD
Dr. Hwang is an assistant professor of ophthalmology who specializes in the medical and surgical treatment of children and adults with retina conditions. Her research lab focuses on studying the vitreous, a transparent gel that fills the back of the eye and contributes to blinding diseases. Dr. Hwang is an ARCS Scholar and participates in the University of Utah Vice President's Clinical & Translational Research Scholars Program.



Beth Armstrong, MBA
Beth is executive director of People's Health Clinic, a nonprofit clinic that provides quality healthcare for the underserved populations of Summit and Wasatch Counties. Beth has more than 25 years of experience in healthcare and hospital administration.
